General objective

Contribute to a sustainable and harmonious cooperation process and promote dialogue in the Mediterranean Sea Basin by outlining, **testing and supporting a multistakeholders Mediterranean mobility framework** that would facilitate educational, cultural and economic exchange as well as social cohesion.

Specific objective

Create a framework of cooperation to support future regulations and **improve and consolidate programmes and initiatives aiming to facilitate the exchange of students, professionals and young entrepreneurs** in the Mediterranean, making it capable to compare with other geographical areas.

Main Activities and Results achieved 1/2

- Research on all relevant mobility programmes (not only EU funded) in the Mediterranean that might be transferable.
- A framework model for mobility in the Mediterranean based on the existing mobility programmes with some proposed improvements according to the particularities of the countries involved and the merging needs of beneficiaries.
- A series of Policy Recommendations based on the lessons learnt for improving the existing mobility programmes.
- Establishment of 4 new mobility offices in MED territories for the organization of mobility programs

- Development of a Capacity Building for Mobility Experts' Program, consisting of:
 - a) A Train the Trainers Seminar
 - b) 4 local training seminars in Jordan, Lebanon and Palestine (Gaza and West Bank)
 - c) Follow-up and assessment of the new mobility professionals

-Development of 20 different pilot mobility actions -some multilateral- addressed to:

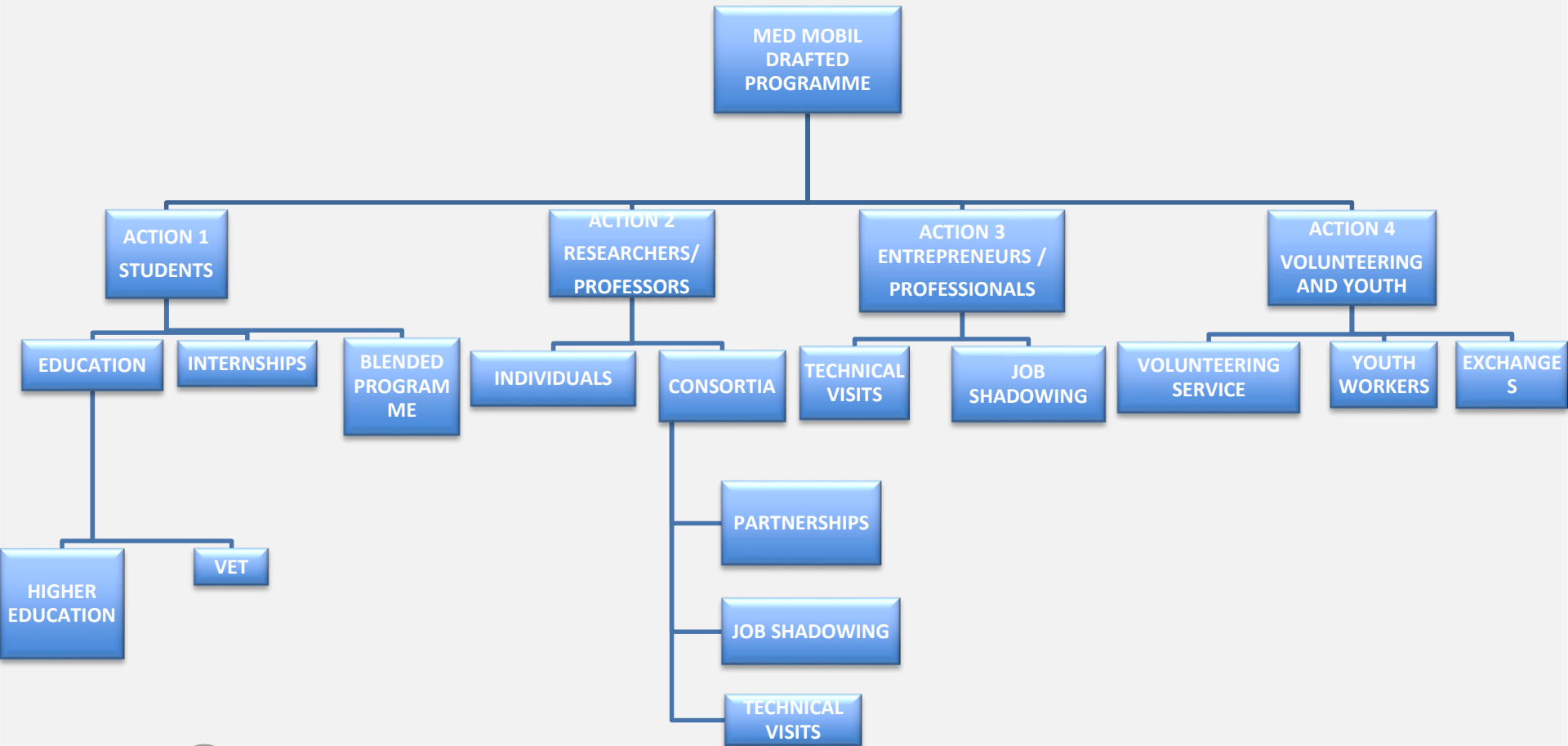
- a) Students
- b) Professors and Researchers
- c) Professionals
- d) Entrepreneurs



192 people beneficiaries

-Organization of 4 cross-cultural events promoting dialogue, cultural and socio-economic exchange: in Jordan, Lebanon and two in Palestine (Gaza and West Bank)

-More than 20 agreements signed (more than 40 organisations cooperated in the pilot actions)
