COMMO I: Approved mobilities

A total of 28 mobilities

- 15 students mobility (in/out)
- 13 academic and non academic staff mobilities (in/out)

Albania

- 10 students mobilities (6 out/6 in)
- 7 staff mobilities (4 out/ 3 in)

Montenegro

- 5 students mobilities (2 out/3 in)
- 6 staff mobilities (3 out/ 3 in)

Obstacles to the Mobility in COMMO experiences



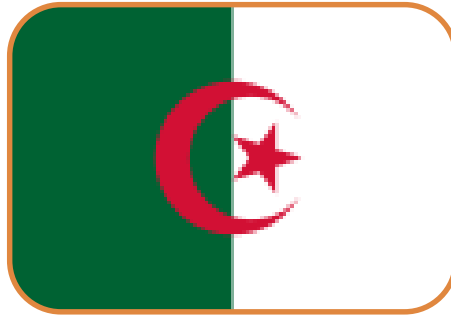
UNIMED role within COMMO project

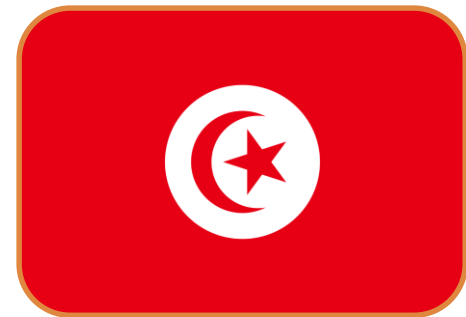
